Research Interests (Statement)

My program of research aims to deliver on the promise of digital technology to understand and improve pediatric health behavior. The long-term goal of this work is to use digital technology to improve the physical and mental health of children and their families by influencing key behaviors such as diet, physical activity, and sleep. In working toward this goal recently, my work has focused on developing digital assessment tools and research methodologies capable of fully harnessing the potential and novel impact of digital technologies. The core of what I do is to use smartphones and sensors to gather and make inferences using a large number of data points from a given individual (in addition to leveraging group-level data). I also have an interest in measure development, and have collaborated with several groups to help develop clinical tools to assess pediatric Health-Related Quality of Life.
